

Instructions for submission to *IJHE – Bildungsgeschichte – International Journal for the Historiography of Education*

General information

- The journal addresses an international audience and maintains scientific *and* at the same time reader-friendly language.
- Please provide a short abstract (max. 100 words) and 3-5 keywords with your paper. For English contributions, please also include the title, abstract and keywords in German; if this is not possible, we will translate them and ask for verification.
- The paper should not exceed the maximum length of 9,000 words (or 60,000 characters including spaces, bibliography and footnotes).
- Illustrations in b/w are possible. Please send them in a separate file (as png, ppg or pdf) including caption and placement within the text. Image rights must be obtained in advance.

Formatting instructions

Text layout

- Emphasis should be marked in *italics*.
- Do not use “page breaks,” “keep lines together,” “keep with next” or “hyphenation.”
- Do not insert an indent at the beginning of the paragraph or any blank lines.

Headings

- Headings should be numbered consecutively (not automatic)
- First order headings: **bold**
- Second order headings: *italics*

List/numeration

For lists, please use dashes; for numbered lists, you may use Latin numbers or letters. Again: please do not insert automatic enumerations.

Tables, figures and footnotes

Please insert table headings and figure captions as headings accordingly. Footnotes should be used sparingly.

Literature/references

The bibliography should be sorted as follows:

- Monographs/anthologies:

Last Name, First Name (Ed.): Book title. Place: Publisher Year
[Smith, Peter: School history. New York: Routledge 2008]

- Contribution:

Last Name, First Name: Title of the contribution. In: First Name Last Name (Ed.): Book title.
Place: Publisher Year, page numbers

[Smith, Peter: School reforms in the twentieth century. In: Richard Miller (Ed.): Curriculum reader. London: Macmillan 2007, 35-46]

- Article:

Last Name, First Name: Title of the article. In: Title of the journal Volume(Year), Issue, page numbers

[Kelly, Lisa: School development. In: *IJHE – Bildungsgeschichte – International Journal for the Historiography of Education* 1(2011), Issue 1, 14-20]
